4. Ensure fire protection equipment firefighters and first responders rely on to be in working order.

Document any fire and life safety issues that may put the public in imminent danger or harm to any person(s) working in unsafe conditions. Follow and apply all related fire code sections, listed below, as described in the 2012 International Fire Code with Phoenix Amendments.
